## Principal's Desk

In last Sunday's Gospel we heard Matthew's account of Jesus feeding the multitude who had followed him with five loaves and two fish. His disciples had said to him "This is a lonely place, and the day is now over; send the crowds away to go into the villages and buy food for themselves." But Jesus replied "They need not go away; you give them something to eat."

This miracle is seen as a foreshadowing of the Eucharistic meal which Christ was to provide miraculously for the multitude of his followers. "Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass; and taking the five loaves and the two fish he looked up to heaven, and blessed, and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds".

This miracle was an act of kindness and loving thoughtfulness on the part of Christ. He saw the people's need and he worked a miracle to provide for this need. The Galileans were grateful to him for providing so kindly and so thoughtfully for their needs. How much more grateful should we be for the miracle by means of which he has left us himself to be our daily spiritual food?

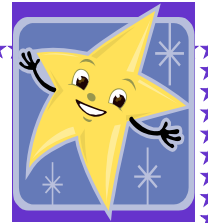

# BILL TURNER TROPHY

The U/15's Girls Soccer team recently completed a very successful season, making it to the Sydney West Regional Final of the Bill Turner Trophy. The Bill Turner Trophy is the largest soccer competition for girls in Australia, regularly attracting in excess of four hundred school teams. The competition is divided into sixteen regions throughout Queensland, New South Wales, ACT and Victoria and is held on the knockout basis.

Our first round match was away to Hawkesbury High School. The girls dominated the match from the outset with the opposition rarely making it into our penalty area. The end result was a comfortable 8-1 win, with goals from Natalie (2), Claudia (2), Timika (2) and Cassidy (2). Our second round match was a walkover when Winmallee High School forfeited the match.

The girl's third round match was away to Blaxland High School. Once again the girls dominated possession, but went into the half-time break with a slender 1-0 lead, due to a few poorly directed shots and some excellent saves from the Blaxland keeper. The girls doubled their advantage in the second half, and finished the match as 2-0 winners. The performance was more dominant than the scoreline indicated, and featured some excellent passing, tackling and running off the ball. Goals came from Cassidy and Timika.

The fourth round was a home match against Xavier College for a place in the Sydney West final. This was an extremely hard fought and even affair, with the midfields and defences of both teams keeping attacking raids to a minimum. The momentum changed after half-time when Keighley moved up front and made some crunching tackles in the opposing penalty box, causing some panic and indecision for the Xavier girls. With five minutes remaining, Cassidy won the ball in midfield and played a diagonal ball through for Lenise, who converted from a difficult angle for a hard fought 1-0 victory.

The regional final was away to Hills Sports High School on their synthetic pitch. After a number of great efforts, the girls found themselves chasing shadows against a very talented and well drilled outfit, and despite their best efforts they were defeated 0-7, with Timika and Keighley making some great saves between the sticks to keep the score under double figures. With all the opposing players being in State League squads, and their teacher/coach currently in charge of the Matildas, it was a good effort against class opposition.

I would like to thank all the girls for their efforts this season—this is only the second time we have progressed to this stage. A big thank you to our Year 10 girls and a number of the Year 9 girls who have reached “veteran” status and have played their final season in this comp. I would also like to thank all the parents who came and supported the team.
