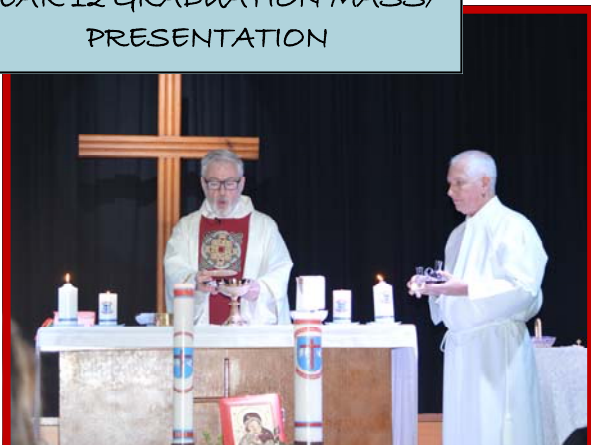

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO MOTORISTS RE SCHOOL BUS ZONES IN RIFLE RANGE ROAD

Please be aware that conditions have changed with the School Bus Zones in Rifle Range Road. These changes are:

1. The existing bus bay near the main car park gate is now a School Bus Zone on School Days from 8:00am-9:30am and 2:30pm-4:00pm. Therefore other than buses - any vehicle parking or stopping in this bus bay for any purpose during these times is doing so illegally. Clear signage has been erected reading "NO ENTRY - BUSES EXCEPTED" to warn motorists of this change.
2. The former School Bus Zone located near the Front Gate has been converted to a Full Time Bus Zone. Clear signage has been erected to warn motorists of this change. Therefore other than buses, any vehicle parking or stopping for any purpose in the School Bus Zone at any time, is doing so illegally.

Congratulations Courtney Dominello and Chelsea Malone - Graduating from Nepean Hospital- Certificate III in Health Services Assistance (Nursing)

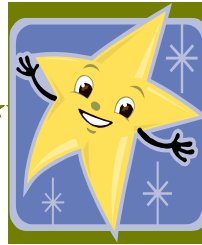
Courtney Dominello and Chelsea Malone have successfully completed a TVET course in Certificate III in Health Services assistance (Nursing) as part of their HSC studies. Both students achieved great results. The students studied this course at Nepean Hospital, one day a week for the last two years, and completed work placement within the hospital with real patients. This qualification has now provided the students the opportunity to work in a hospital immediately as a Nursing Assistant.

Nepean Hospital has offered the students casual work after their HSC examination, they also stated when a full time position becomes available, the students will be given first priority. Given they achieved a Cert III qualification, the students have also been granted access to the Bachelor of Nursing program at Notre Dame and Western Sydney University without an ATAR. Nepean Hospital will make them a priority to complete future work placement as part of their university or TAFE course in Nursing.

What a fantastic opportunity and experience these two students have had. They have gained real employment qualifications whilst studying the HSC.

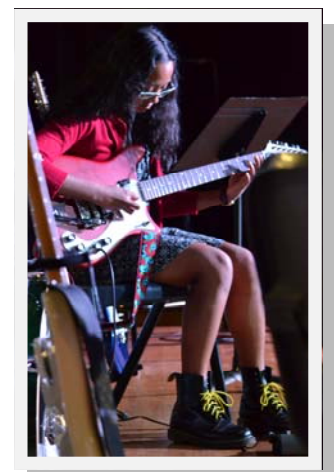
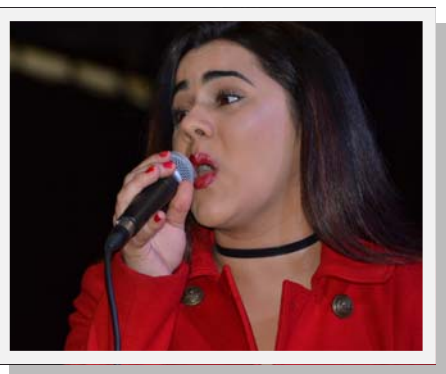
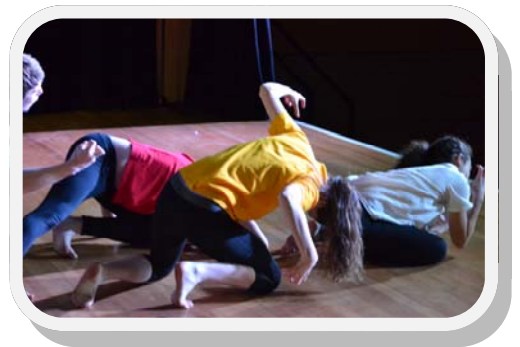
