Plans are underway to involve a number of students from Years 7-10 in an exciting Social Justice themed excursion. On Friday 10 August, 50 students will visit the Sydney Jewish Museum, (SJM) in Darlinghurst. This museum features Holocaust and Australian Jewish history. The students will participate in the specialised program, *Confronting Bullying*. This program has been designed for students in Years 7-10. The SJM educates about the Nazi Genocide in WWII in order to promote tolerance and recognition of difference in today's society. *Confronting Bullying* addresses the roles that participants take in bullying episodes: Perpetrator, Victim, Bystander and Resistor. The program is centred on empowering students to lead in creating a school environment in which bullying is never acceptable. Invitations to attend the excursion will be distributed in Week 9.

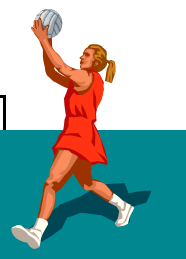
